Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute (charge with) iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit" (Psalm 32:1-2). Many people through out history have taken their lives because of the heavy weight of their guilt which they could not bear. When David had unconfessed sin, he was in great misery and said: "When I kept silent, my bones grew old through my groaning all the day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; my vitality was turned into the drought of summer" (Psalm 32:3-4). And in Psalm 51, the famous Psalm that was written after David committed murder and adultery; David cries to the LORD saying: "Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.... Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me hear joy and gladness, that the bones You have broken may rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me.
