# The Goodness of the Lord

### **God is Love**

The bible says that God is "love." Love is the very essence and the very nature of God. God displays and showers His love upon us every day by providing food for us and healing our bodies of sicknesses. God even shows His love to the wicked and to the undeserving. The bible says that "He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust" (Matt. 5:45). In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins." (1 John 4:7-10)

"For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Rom. 5:6-8)

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

#### **God is Merciful**

The bible says that God is "merciful." What is mercy? Mercy is not giving us what we deserve. The bible says that God is compassionate and abounding in mercy. How great is God's mercy you might wander? Go outside and look up to the Heavens! The bible says to you that "as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward those who fear Him" (Psalm 103:11).

As a father pities his children, So the Lord pities those who fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust." (Psalm 103:8-14)

"But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth." (Psalm 86:15)

"Be ve therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful." (Luke 6:36)

#### **God is Gracious**

The bible says that God is "gracious." What is grace? Grace is giving us what we do not deserve. Grace is the unmerited and undeserved favor of God toward man. God displayed His grace to us by giving us salvation free by simply trusting in His Son the Lord Jesus. Salvation is free and it is the gift of God to us.

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Rom. 6:23)

Why do you spend money for what is not bread, And your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, And let your soul delight itself in abundance. "Say to them: 'As I live,' says the Lord God, 'I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live. Turn, turn from your evil ways! For why should you die, O house of Israel?'" (Ezek. 33:11)
